

Together, we'll be crossing through rivers in the 4x4s, check out high country huts, and stand atop towering mountains, Pickup and drop-off is at the Hay Visitor Information Centre at 7am 6 Feb / 20 Feb.

## DAY 1 - TUE 6/20 FEB

We'll find camp on the banks of the King River and make ourselves comfy. There are some good swimming holes and decent fishing opportunities for trout. Time to collect fire wood, get that fire going and dinner on the go.

#### DAY 2 - WED 7/21 FEB

After brekky, we'll head off to climb steep 4x4 tracks with a break for lunch (and a swim!) before we hit the first of 7 river crossings, and then we set up camp with enough time to have a swim and fish and some games, too. PS - the fishing in this spot is pretty special.

## DAY 3 - THU 8/22 FEB

We pack up camp and head up to Mt Cobbler, leaving the cars at the lake and make our way up a goat track to the summit - 360 degree views! Once back down, we'll track across to Craig's Hut where we'll stay for the night. It's a ripper spot for a sunset with 100km views. Let's get that fire going and settle in.

## DAY 4 - FRI 9/23 FEB

We'll hit the 4x4 tracks one more time, crawling over the top of one of the area's tallest mountains. Time to air up and head to Mansfield for a feed! Back in Hay around 7pm.
